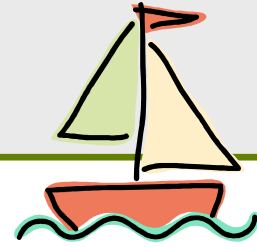

Hunting Laws, Regulations, and Safety

The ESD and Nicolet Neighborhood Associations are co-sponsoring a forum on Wisconsin hunting laws and regulations and hunting safety on Thursday, August 19th, at 7:00 p.m. in the Bay Beach Wildlife Sanctuary Auditorium. The event is FREE and open to the public. Representatives from the state DNR, the Green Bay Police Department, Ducks Unlimited, and other invited guests will be leading an informative discussion on enforcement of the existing laws and regulations as well as ways to ensure the safety of all neighborhood residents during hunting season.
