This evening at 1817 hrs the Green Bay Fire Department responded to a single story single family residence. First crews arrived within five minutes of the alarm and had moderate flames coming from the rear of the structure. The fire was quickly extinguished. Everyone was out of the residence on our arrival. A total of eight fire department units responded with 21 personnel. There were no injuries reported. The six displaced residents are being aided by the American Red Cross. We were aided at the scene by GBPD, GBPW, WPS and The American Red Cross.
