FLOWERS AND PLANTERS

We would like to thank the residents who contributed and Schroeder's Flowers for the generous material and financial donations we received this year! We have six large planters on Lombardi Ave. across from Lambeau Field which we maintain. They are coming along fine thanks in part to the Packers organization watering them for us.

We also have the neighborhood sign and flower berm at the corner of Liberty and Gatewood. This now contains a majority of perennials and the remainder are annuals. We have started to put up plant labels and in the future may possibly put in a curbscape around the berm. The flowers and the ornamental grasses should continue to improve if the sun stays out and we can keep the rabbits at bay.

STORM DRAIN INLETS

Just a reminder that there are many storm drain inlets that need adopting. Keeping them clear of debris will help the water to drain when it rains and hopefully lessen the flooding our neighbors experienced last year. We have done a great job on the fire hydrants now hopefully we can do the same with the inlet drains.

YARD WASTE

Yard waste pickup has ended for the summer and will resume in the fall, around the end of Sept. If you place yard waste out at the curb it may be there awhile and damage your lawn.

There is a revised city ordinance on properties where the grass/weeds are too long (over 9"). Resident will receive a notice on the door and have 24 hours to mow the property. Public works will then mow property and send you an invoice. It's not cheap, fines start around \$125.00. Repeat offenders will have property mowed without any notice & may be susceptible to municipal citations. Vacant properties will be mowed with no notice.

FYI

Please clean up after your pets and don't dispose of droppings in public/park receptacles. Animal waste is not allowed in garbage cans. Owners are expected to bury animal feces. A posting on the public works website states that **NO ANIMAL DROPPINGS** will be picked up by the City Department of Public Works. Fines start at \$361.00 and go up to \$661.00 if the problem continues.

Likewise, **NO DOMESTIC DEAD ANIMALS** will be picked up by the City Department of Public Works; owner must dispose of these types of materials. For animal injuries or fatalities on roadways, call Green Bay Police Department Animal control Officer at (920) 448-3200 or Bay Area Humane society at (920) 469-3110.
