City of Green Bay Reminds Residents of Energy Audit Rebate Program Deadline- There's Still Time for Savings!

GREEN BAY– The City of Green Bay's Home Energy Audit Rebate Program will be ending on June 1, 2012. Thanks to a federal energy grant, the City offers its Home Energy Audit Rebate Program to residents of the City with up to \$200 in rebates to help cover the cost of an energy audit. Energy audits cost approximately \$350. City residents interested in this program can still apply through the end of May with the understanding that the program will no longer be funded after June 1, 2012.

Residents who complete an energy audit then have access to additional rebates for energy efficient improvements including insulation, new furnaces, and more. The City's program helps lower the cost of energy audits to residents thereby making them eligible for additional rebates on home improvements.

Currently, there are 70 program participants who have completed the City's program. On average, participating residents saved 52% of their energy audit AND home improvement costs by participating in the City of Green Bay's Home Energy Audit Rebate Program and receiving subsequent home improvement rebates from Focus on Energy and Wisconsin Public Service.
