Q: When is the collection event held?

A: Collections will be held throughout the year at several locations. Please call the Recycling Hotline below for details.

Q: What is accepted?

A: Pills, liquids, inhalers, capsules, sprays, drops, ointments, creams, and pet medications.

Q: What will happen to the medications collected?

A: They will be destroyed at a licensed facility.

Q: Will I have to pay anything?

A: No, these are free events for Brown County Residents.

Q: Do I have to do anything special with the medications ahead of time?

A: Remove from original packaging if you can.

Q: Will any personal information be collected?

A: No.

Q: How long will it take to drop off unused medications?

A: As long as it takes to park and walk into the drop off location.

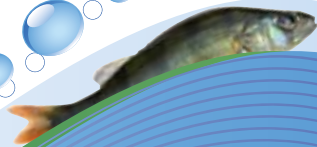
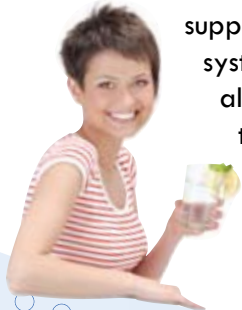

Attention Brown County Residents!

Hazards to improperly disposing of unwanted medications by throwing out or flushing are:

- Children and pets may inadvertently ingest medications, which could lead to harm or death.
- Medications could be scavenged from trash receptacles or stolen from the home and illegally sold or abused.
- Contamination of water resources, by passing through wastewater plants, which could lead to reproductive problems in aquatic species.
 - Contamination of drinking water supplies. Many municipal water systems are unable to filter out all medications before entering the drinking water supply.



TIPS

You Should:

- Reduce medication waste whenever possible. Buy only as much as you can use in the immediate future.
- Dispose of any medications properly by using Brown County's medication collection events.

You Should NOT:

- Flush drugs down the toilet or sink drain.
- Burn medications or personal care products in a burn barrel.
- Place medications in your trash.

Accepted items for the collection drive include:

- Pills
- Capsules
- Ointments
- Liquids
- Sprays
- Creams
- Inhalers
- Drops
- Pet Medications

Non-accepted items for the collection drive include:

- Sharps
- Syringes
- Lancets
- Biological Waste
- Institutional/healthcare waste

Artículos aceptados en la unidad de colección:

- Píldoras
- Capsulas
- Pomadas
- Líquidos
- Atomizadores
- Cremas
- Inaladores
- Gotas
- Medicina para mascotas

Artículos no aceptados en la unidad de colección:

- Punzocortantes
- Jeringas

- Desecho institucional/ de cuidado de salud.

Atencion Residentes de Brown County!

Los peligros de la eliminación impropia de medicina no deseada por tirarla en la basura o en lavados son:

- Niños y mascotas pueden ingerirlos inesperadamente lo cual puede llevarlos a hacerle daño o muerte.
- Los medicinas pueden ser escavados de los recipientes de basura ó robados de casa e ilegalmente vendidos o alterados.
- Contaminación de recursons de agua , pasando por plantes de aguas residuales, las cuals pueden llevar a problemas reproductivos en especies acuáticas.
- Contaminación de fuentes de agua para beber. Muchos sistmasd e Fuentes de agua municipal no estan disponibles para filtrar todas las medicinas antes de entrar a las fuentes de agua.

CONSEJOS:

Tiene que:

- Reducir el desperdicio de medicina cuando sea posible. Comprar solo lo que usted use en un futuro cercano.

- Deseche cualquier medicamento apropiadamente usando la unidad de colección de medicina del condado de Brown.

No tiene que:

- Vaciar las drogas en la taza del baño o en el lava manos.
- Quemar medicina o productos de cuidado personal en un tonel quemado.
- Colocar medicina en la basura.
