

Program Requirements

- ✓ The applicant must be a residential property owner in the City of Green Bay.
- ✓ Each property owner is only eligible for up to \$200 in rebate incentives.
- ✓ The homeowner must provide receipts for the home inspection and projects completed.
- ✓ The rebate application form must be completed in its entirety, including all required signatures.
- ✓ To receive the second reimbursement the home owner must complete at least two home improvements within six months of the date the original audit took place.
- ✓ The consultant must be approved by Focus on Energy.
- ✓ The homeowner must be current on all property taxes and City issued invoices.

The City of Green Bay invites City residents to take advantage of the Home Energy Audit Rebate Program. Homeowners can qualify to receive up to \$200 in rebates to cover the cost of a home energy audit. The audit will

inform residents of problem areas in the home which are causing higher energy bills as well as recommendations on how to fix or upgrade inefficiencies. With many rebates and cash incentives currently available, now is the perfect time to take the first step towards a greener, less expensive future!

Who is Eligible?

- ✓ All residential property owners (owner of rental properties and owner-occupied homes).
- ✓ Residents must be current on property taxes & other City invoices.
- ✓ Property must be within the City of Green Bay city limits.



Get Started!

- ✓ Fill out an application by visiting City Hall or go online to www.green-bay.org and select the Sustainable Green Bay web link.
- ✓ Visit the Economic Development Department for initial consultation and preapproval.
- ✓ Call a Focus on Energy certified consultant and schedule your audit.



Get Paid!

Bring the audit report, receipts, and application to the Economic Development Department, City Hall, Room 200 for review. Complete applications will be sent a \$100 rebate check via mail within 7-10 days.

More Rebates Available!

The City's Home Energy Audit Rebate Program isn't the only financial assistance available! Several upgrades and projects qualify for Focus on Energy cash back rewards.

WPS has partnered with Focus on Energy to offer additional cash back incentives on energy efficient improvements. These incentives won't last forever, so ask your consultant for more details!

Other available incentives include:

- ✓ Tax credits for renewable energy improvements including geothermal and solar heating systems.
- ✓ Low income & assistance programs for energy saving improvements.
- ✓ Fixed rate energy loans.

That's Not All!

If a homeowner decides to implement at least two of the recommendations from the audit, they may be eligible for a second \$100 rebate towards the initial cost of the audit. The Focus on Energy consultant must verify the upgrades.
