# What is a Home Energy Audit?

- A home energy audit is an evaluation by a qualified professional to analyze energy flow and usage in a residential dwelling.
- The purpose of an energy audit is to determine inefficiencies in energy consumption (i.e. leaks, drafts, old equipment) and to inform homeowners of available upgrades and anticipated savings.
- The goal of an energy audit is to provide recommendations that will improve the energy efficiency, human comfort, safety and health of a home.

# So what's this rebate program all about?

Green Bay residents may qualify for up to \$200 in rebates to help cover the costs of conducting a home energy audit. To be eligible, homeowners must:

- Reside in Green Bay city limits
- Be current on all taxes and monies owed to the City

**DO YOU QUALIFY??**

## How it works:

- Eligible homeowners should visit City Hall or go online ([www.ci.green-bay.wi.us/SGB/](http://www.ci.green-bay.wi.us/SGB/)) to fill out an application.
- They must get a pre-approval signature from the Economic Development Department PRIOR to conducting the energy audit.
- Following pre-approval, homeowners schedule an audit with a Focus on Energy-certified consultant.



## And then...

- The consultant will provide a list of recommended purchases and upgrades to help reduce wasted energy consumption in your home.
- Bring your application and receipt for the audit to City Hall to receive a \$100 rebate check (sent via mail.)


- Homeowners may choose to implement recommendations from the audit to qualify for a second rebate of \$100.
- At least TWO upgrades must be completed within 6 months to receive the rebate.
- The consultant **MUST** inspect and verify that recommendations were fully implemented.



- Fill out the second form, attach the approval from your audit consultant and show City Hall what you've done!
- Another \$100 rebate will be mailed within 7-10 business days upon receipt of complete application submittal.

# Don't Forget!

**Mention that Sustainable Green Bay sent you and \$75 from your energy audit cost will be donated to the taskforce to help support community-wide sustainable initiatives!**



**How is the City paying for this program? Are these MY property tax dollars at work?**

Nope! In late 2009, the City of Green Bay was awarded a \$1,003,000 award from the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) to complete building retrofits and green programs for residents.
