The history of Bay Beach dates back to 1892 when a young entrepreneur, Mitchell Nejedlo, was attracted to the natural beauty of the area along the bay. He purchased a small strip of land at the north end of Irwin Avenue and began developing it for a private beach resort which he named Bay View Beach.

Owned by the City of Green Bay since 1920, this 17 acre facility attracts over a half million visitors each season. The park features 17 rides, numerous shelters, concession stands and a ball diamond. The main Pavilion gives park goers a place to rest out of the sun and offers a full concession menu.
