During his first year in office, in 2003, Green Bay Mayor Jim Schmitt initiated the first Kids' Day. Admission is free and they enjoy the daylong events beginning with Lunch with the Mayor in a major city park. Games abound at the park and other activities are offered all over the City. Each child picks up a wristband which allows them free access to activities such as movies, bowling, tours of the National Railroad Museum and Neville Public Museum, a Green Bay Bullfrogs baseball game Bay Beach Amusement Park and more. The afternoon is capped off with a live animal release at the Bay Beach Wildlife Sanctuary.
