

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 4-10

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 29.208,
GREEN BAY MUNICIPAL CODE,
RELATING TO PARKING REGULATIONS

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN BAY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 29.208, Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended by removing therefrom the following TWO-HOUR PARKING 7:00 AM – 4:00 PM SCHOOL DAYS zone:

TILKENS STREET, both sides, from Tommark Street to Oneida Street

SECTION 2. Section 29.208, Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended by removing therefrom the following TWO-HOUR PARKING 7:00 AM – 4:00 PM zones:

HOWARD STREET, north side, from Oak Street to Twelfth Avenue

HOWARD STREET, south side, from a point 100 feet west of Yale Street to a point 40 feet west of Thirteenth Avenue

SECTION 3. Section 29.208, Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following TWO-HOUR PARKING 7:00 AM – 4:00 PM zones:

HOWARD STREET, north side, from Yale Street to Twelfth Avenue

HOWARD STREET, south side, from Yale Street to a point 40 feet west of Thirteenth Avenue

SECTION 4. Section 29.208, Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following NO PARKING zone:

BADGER STREET, north side, from Regan Street to a point 370 feet west of Siegler Street

SECTION 5. Section 29.208, Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended by removing therefrom the following NO PARKING zone:

LEO FRIGO WAY, west side, from a point 50 feet north of Weise Street to a point 30 feet south of Weise Street

SECTION 6. Section 29.208, Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following 15-MINUTE PARKING 7:00 AM – 4:00 PM MONDAY – FRIDAY zone:

LEO FRIGO WAY, west side, from a point 50 feet north of Weise Street to a point 85 feet south of Weise Street

SECTION 7. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall take effect on and after its passage and publication.

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 5-10

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 29.307,
GREEN BAY MUNICIPAL CODE,
RELATING TO TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN BAY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 29.307, Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended by removing therefrom the following YIELD condition:

Southbound Right-Turn on QUINCY STREET at UNIVERSITY AVENUE

SECTION 2. Section 29.307, Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following NO RIGHT ON RED WHEN CHILDREN ARE PRESENT condition:

Eastbound EAST MASON STREET at ALPINE DRIVE

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect on and after its passage and publication.

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 6-10

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 2.06,
GREEN BAY MUNICIPAL CODE,
RELATING TO STANDING COMMITTEES; MATTERS REFERRED

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN BAY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2.06, Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended as follows:

2.06 (15) ACTION OF COUNCIL LEVYING TAXES OR CREATING LIABILITY. Except upon the unanimous consent of all members present, no resolutions or measure assessing or levying taxes, appropriating or disbursing money, or creating any liability or charge against the City or any fund thereof shall be adopted without first having been referred to a committee and the report thereon of such committee having been made to the Council, unless the resolution is one that carries into effect the action of the Council upon a committee report. All ordinances and resolutions adopted shall specify the levy or liability impact to the City of Green Bay.

SECTION 2. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect on and after its passage and publication.
