

A CHARTER ORDINANCE11
CREATING THE OFFICE OF
CITY ATTORNEY EMERITUS

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN BAY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. This is a charter ordinance enacted pursuant to Section 66.01, Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 2. There is hereby created the office of City Attorney Emeritus.

SECTION 3. The qualification for the office of City Attorney Emeritus is a continuous twenty years or more of above ordinary service rendered to the City as City Attorney. The appointment shall be made by the Mayor and shall be for an indefinite term. The City shall furnish, without charge, desk space in the City Hall for the length of the term. The chief executive, the governing body, and the City Attorney may call upon the City Attorney Emeritus for advice and counsel, when the giving of such advice and counsel does not conflict with any other position he may be holding.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect on and after its passage and publication.
